

## Planned Parenthood! Family Planning!

Planned Parenthood California Central Coast is proud to serve Santa Barbara, Ventura and San Luis Obispo Counties with high-quality health care, education programs, and advocacy for reproductive health and rights.

Last year, our 5 health centers provided care to nearly 33,000 patients through nearly 55,000 health center visits. On February 5th, 2018, we were delighted to open a brand-new satellite health center in Paso Robles!

Our health centers provide lifesaving health care, including breast and cervical cancer screenings, sexually transmitted infection testing and treatment, birth control, and safe and legal abortion.

Last year we also began providing treatment for syphilis as we saw rates increase along the Central Coast. We also started providing cutting-edge medications – PrEP and PEP – which safely reduce the risk of HIV infection.

Our education programs serve nearly 1,000 teens each year with evidence-based programming, which is proven to reduce rates of unintended pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections. Thousands more benefit from outreach: Planned Parenthood has a presence at health and community fairs, reaching people with information and free condoms. Last year, we distributed over 600,000 condoms in our three counties.

Last year, we did all of this while under unprecedented attack by Congress and a new administration.

As we fought back, we weren't alone. Our supporters gave generously, rallied with us, called their senators and members of Congress, marched, and spoke up about the need to support Planned Parenthood.

Because of everyone who stood with us, we were successful at preventing Congress from harming our patients. The fight isn't over; we know we must remain diligent. That's why we are so grateful for your support. Together, we will keep our doors open, no matter what!
